LOCATION

THE CEREMONY



The registrar from Bandarawela can conduct your ceremony here in the resort. For the marriage ceremony, we would recommend setting up a "Poruwa". The "Poruwa" is similar to a stage and is traditionally decorated with coconut leaves. The "aisles" would be decorated with lovely branches & leaves.

The Bride will then be called from her Suite by a young boy blowing a conch shell, with two drummers and a parade of Kandyan dancers, who will escort her to the Poruwa at the garden, where her Groom and all the guests will be waiting. The Master of Ceremonies will perform the exchange of vows and giving

of the sheaf of betel leaves, the tying of index fingers of the bride and groom with water poured being poured on them from a Kandyan silver jug.

After the ceremony, the bride and groom will be invited to light the oil lamp, before they proceed to the wedding registration at a decorated table. This will be followed by cutting of the wedding cake/local milk rice, and champagne toast.





THE RECEPTION AND THE DINNER



Our excellent chef can prepare a wide range of canapés, wedding dinners and wedding cakes especially local cuisine to add local glamour to your special day. We can also arrange wines and champagnes.

For entertainment, we can arrange local musicians, or even a DJ for the dancing after the dinner.

Depending on your theme and styles you want, we can arrange flowers, lights, candles, ginipandans (Sri Lankan flaming torches), Vesak lanterns and fireworks accordingly.

DECORATIONS



This will be done in discussion with the bride and groom, though it would be done in keeping with LHKoslanda's style. We can cater for everything from flowers to candles and lighting.

THE CONDITIONS

LEGALITIES

The required documents to be married in Sri Lanka are:

- Your birth certificates
 - Your passports (copies are only required of the information pages- pages containing immigration and visa stamps are not required)
 - A letter stating your full name, postal address and occupation
 - A letter stating the full names, addresses and occupations of your parents
- An affidavit confirming the your status (Married / Single / Divorced / Widowed)

Duplicate copies of these needs to be forwarded to the hotel 4 weeks prior to the date of the ceremony.

If, by any chance any of the following apply to you, we will also need duplicate copies of the following documents 4 weeks prior to the ceremony:

- If divorced decree absolute(s)
- Legal proof of any name changes by Deed Poll
- If widowed a) Death certificate(s) of former spouse. b) Previous marriage certificate(s)
- If adopted legal forms
- If any document provided is not in English, then a legally recognized translator must provide a translation.



- And last, but not least, the happy couple must travel to Sri Lanka with all the original documentation 5 days prior to the wedding.
 - (For stamps and Notary the charge is USD250 net)

Solo musician plays the bamboo flute performing gentle background music. Also "Jayamangala Gatha" is played by the Flutist when lighting Traditional lamp just after the ceremony.
